## Curriculum

## Teaching Force

## Grading

Our grading system is presented in per-semester basis that lasts for a 6-month duration each. Results shown at the end of every June and December will be seen as the followings:

## Graduation Requirement

In Methodist Charles Wesley, several requirements are set in evaluating whether or not a student is eligible to graduate or move on to the next level.

## Average Score

The basic criteria will be attaining the minimum average score of 70.

## Attitude

A student's attitude is crucial in determining whether or not they will graduate or remain at the school. Within the studying period, warnings will be given and students will be constantly evaluated by both teachers in charge as well as the school's disciplinary members. Should students behave inappropriately and break rules, their graduating credibility will be reconsidered.

## Attendance

A minimum of 90% attendance should be fulfilled by every respective student. However, a reprieve will be given accordingly and adjusted with special conditions or needs such as participation in competitions, health conditions as well as other emerging emergencies.
